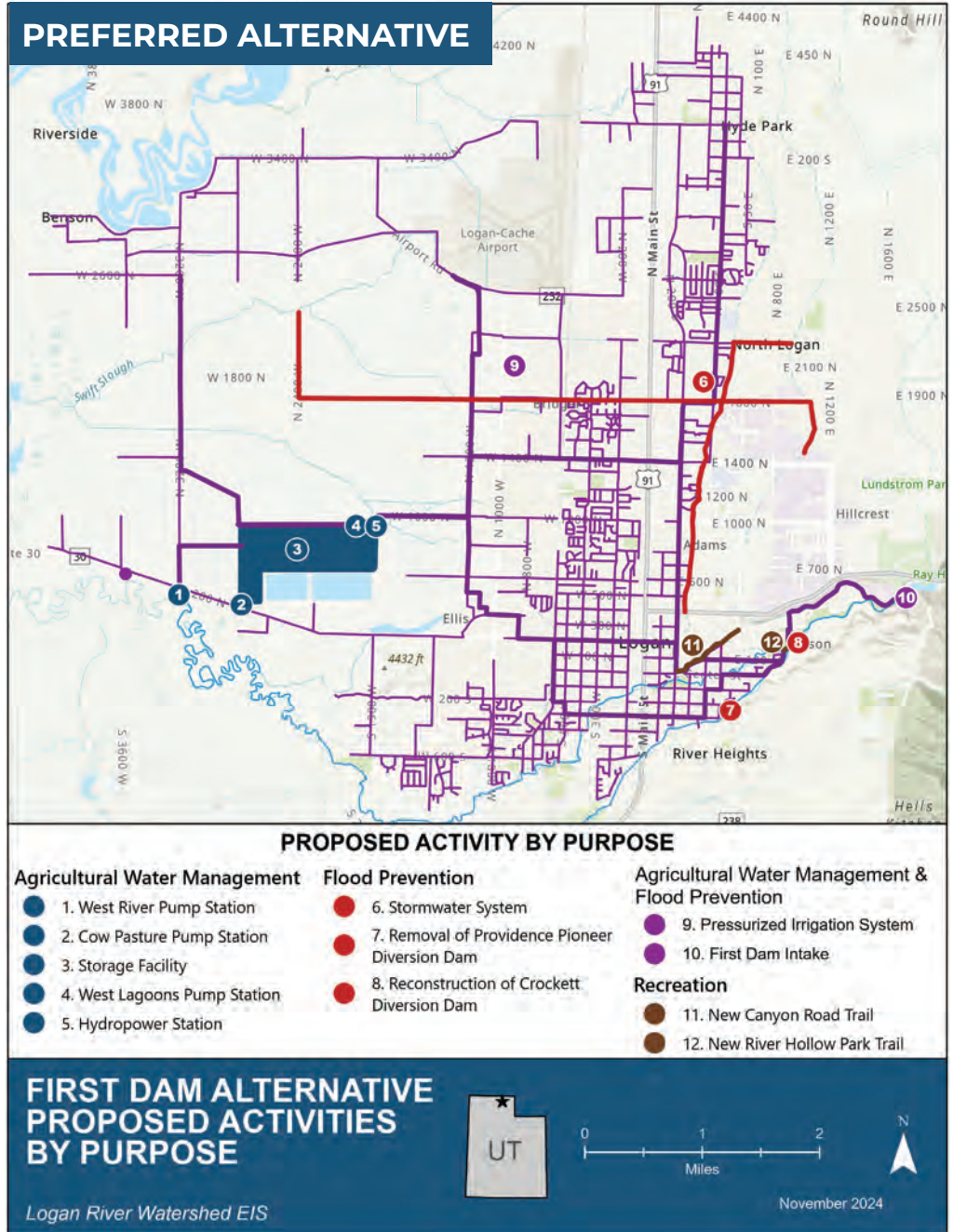


PROJECT UPDATE

The U.S. Department of Agriculture’s Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS), with the Cache Water District, Logan City, North Logan City, Hyde Park City, and Crockett Avenue Irrigation Company as the project Sponsors, has prepared a Draft Plan-Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Logan River Watershed in Cache County, Utah. The Draft Plan-EIS is funded through the NRCS Watershed Protection and Flood Prevention Program (Public Law 83-566).

The authorized purposes for watershed planning and preparation of the Draft Plan-EIS are agricultural water management, flood prevention, and public recreation. The alternatives presented in the Draft Plan-EIS propose to improve irrigation efficiency, conserve water, preserve instream flows, reduce flood risk, and enhance recreational opportunities.

The NRCS and project sponsors will hold a Public Comment Meeting to provide information and solicit comments on the Draft Plan-EIS during the 45-day comment period (May 8–June 22). Comments are requested on the Draft Plan-EIS alternatives and the potential effects. Interested parties may voice their ideas and concerns and submit written comments to NRCS and the project Sponsors during this meeting.
